How it works

You'll use a sliding scale to tell us how much you agree or disagree. Once you've submitted your answer, you'll see the results to date from the rest of the sector instantly.

There's also a space to leave free text comments to expand on your response.

Invaluable insight

UK Heritage Pulse is our collaborative research project gathering views from across the sector. Your invaluable insight will be used to shape the future of heritage funding and strategy at the Heritage Fund, and our partner organisations.
